

## **Eagle Project Ideas (non-construction)**

- Arrange for a Bike Safety Day at the Elementary School which includes guest speakers, a safety video, obstacle course, instructions, bike repairs, and application of reflector tapes and demonstrations.
- Clear, clean, remove rocks and weeds and level a vacant lot in order to have a baseball field.
- Create a program to help parents and parents-to-be understand the importance of reading to their children.
- Help develop an environmental learning center at a community college or similar organization.
- Lead hands-on activities to raise Autism awareness and distribute information to the community.
- Research, plan, coordinate, and implement a historical/genealogical survey of a local cemetery, including cataloging the locations and documenting the inscriptions of all headstones.
- Restore a historic cemetery by clearing debris, replacing decorations, and respectfully cleaning headstones.
- Clean and restore bus shelters by removing litter and graffiti.
- Sponsor a free weeklong sports camp for 120 kids who couldn't otherwise afford to attend.
- Plant vegetation along a water line to serve as an animal habitat and to reduce erosion from water runoff.
- Plan and plant a garden to help preserve native plant species with informational signs to educate the public on native species.
- Create a habitat for endangered monarch butterflies by planting an acre of milkweed seeds over available land.
- Install AED machines and emergency trauma kits in community centers to prepare for possible emergencies.
- Organize knitters and quilters to make blankets for the neonatal intensive care unit at a local hospital.
- Organize a greyhound adoption event, raise awareness about retired racing greyhounds and hold a collection drive for dog toys, treats and towels for the dogs in foster care.
